Cost and eligibility:

You may be entitled to study for **free**, subject to eligibility criteria.

To be eligible, you must:

- Live in **Brighton & Hove**
- Be **19 or older** at the start of the academic year

Be either:

- Unemployed and receiving a means-tested benefit, or
- Employed and earning less than **£25,750 gross per year**
